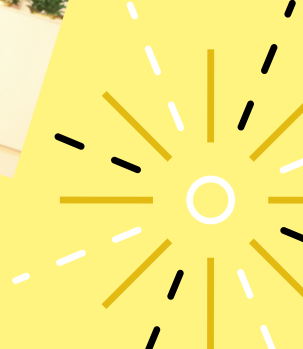

2018 Distinguished Alumni Award Winner - Kathy Losinski ('72)

When I walked into Bishop Foley High School in 1968, my graduating class—the Class of '72—made the school complete. That was the first year that Bishop Foley enrolled students in grades 9 through 12. Not only did we complete the school, but in some ways, the school completed me. That first day, I was a very shy 13 year old who knew one other person in the school. I felt welcomed by my fellow classmates and it was not long before I learned that joining in after school activities was the best way to get to know other people and make friends. I worked on the Homecoming planning committee. I joined the French Club, the Math Club; I tried out for the play and worked stage crew. I even joined the JCL (Latin Club) in spite of the fact that I did not take Latin. Occasionally, my family makes fun of me for being such a nerd, but through those activities, I learned the value of teamwork, of accepting others and allowing myself to be accepted by strangers. I learned that serving my surrounding community was fun and fulfilling. As time went on I grew and made lasting friendships that I still hold dear 45 years later.



Today, I am the Executive Director of a human service organization called Neighborhood House in Rochester, which serves over 3,200 households residing in my community. With a staff of 12 and a dedicated base of 400 volunteers, we work together providing basic emergency services and self-sufficiency skills that will improve the lives of economically disadvantaged individuals living within our neighborhood. What I learned at Bishop Foley comes to life in my work every single day. I am comfortable welcoming the stranger and joining with others to solve complex problems. I am able to ask for help and I am happy to be of service so my efforts can contribute to the overall health of our area. At Neighborhood House, our "corporate" goal is to help make the lives of our neighbors in need complete. We want to help our visitors grow strong and independent, as I did at Bishop Foley.

Thank you to the committee that chose me to represent the Distinguished Alumni of Bishop Foley this year. During all these years, many graduates have distinguished themselves in hundreds of ways. I appreciate the opportunity to share the lasting bond I feel toward the Class of '72 and how my experiences at Bishop Foley continue to impact me and many people who live right down the road from 32000 Campbell. I am very grateful for what I learned at Bishop Foley High School and for this honor.

Foley Alumna Committed to

Being a Servant Leader

Bishop Foley Catholic alumna, Laurel Krause '18, is an inspiration and testament to our Catholic faith. Last summer she volunteered for an international service trip to Costa Rica with Global Leadership Adventures. The program seeks teenagers across the United States and matches them to various programs overseas. Laurel traveled by herself for this travel abroad program and was matched with a girl from North Carolina as her roommate. That takes courage to do at such a young age!

She initially learned about the organization from her sister, Marianne. “After my older sister returned from Costa Rica a few years ago, she raved about her experience with Global Leadership Adventure. I figured it would be an excellent way to learn more about myself and an opportunity to travel abroad,” Krause stated.

The non-profit organization offered a few options for the type of service project she preferred. Considering Laurel has an athletic background, she selected the Sports Adventure program in Costa Rica. What was so fitting is that this former Foley soccer player was assigned to help clean up a recreation area, which happened to be a soccer field. During the day, volunteers helped paint trash cans and the recreation site name on the scoreboard.

They also painted a mural with children playing soccer on the bleachers. During her stay, she interacted with 10 fellow volunteers, three leaders from the organization, and members from the Costa Rican community. While at the job site, there was limited transportation. Each day they had to walk to and from the work site and afternoon activities. She stated that they probably walked around 10 miles each day.

In addition to service hours, the volunteers had an opportunity to explore Costa Rica. Each day they had time permitted to learn more about the country’s culture and enjoy recreational activities. A few of her favorite activities included surfing in the ocean and white water rafting. “The most memorable part of the trip was spending time with the local children, surfing and (eating) the amazing food. They also had the best coffee... no need to put any sugar or cream in it! If I had the opportunity, I would go back in a heartbeat,” replied Krause.

As Christians we are called to help our neighbors and help those less fortunate. This includes helping people in our local community, nationwide, and internationally. This volunteer abroad trip has proven that Krause is a servant leader and committed to BFC’s mission and identity. ❖

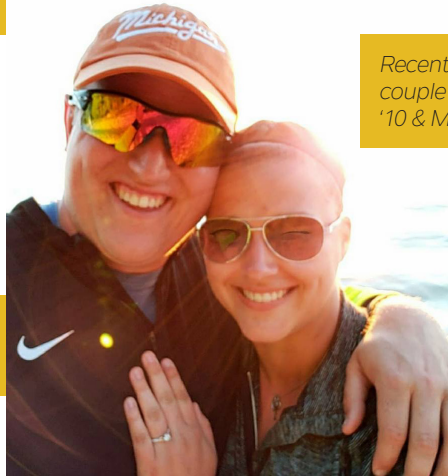
